## EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST ARE NOW OPEN FOR LANDHOLDERS IN THE GOULBURN DISTRICT

## What is Rivers of Carbon?

Rivers like the Wollondilly, Mulwaree and Lachlan are highly valued by the people who live, farm and spend time along them. It is the strong connection people feel to their rivers, creeks and wetlands that has resulted in the Rivers of Carbon: Goulburn District River Linkages project being funded by the New South Wales Environmental Trust Bush Connect Program. Over the next 10 years, we will be working with landowners, community groups, government and non-government agencies to protect and restore rivers across the district for a range of social, economic and environmental benefits.

Our Rivers of Carbon model approach protects remnant (old) intact vegetation first, and then seeks to enhance that vegetation along rivers to connect 'riparian' habitat. Riparian land is important because it is often the most fertile and productive part of the landscape, in terms of both agricultural production and natural ecosystems.

## What does Rivers of Carbon offer?

We are working with 35 landholders to protect and enhance 40 kilometres of riparian corridor, as well as linking 2,200 hectares of remnant vegetation. We stay in touch with these landowners, supporting them and providing advice as needed, until the project ends in 2025. A number of incentives are available including fencing, a subsidy towards alternative stock water, tubestock and direct seeding. Our target is to plant 24,500 tubestock and 50 kilometres of direct seeding using local provenance native seed. We also offer any landholders who work with us a free Land for Wildlife assessment to provide them with further knowledge about the environmental value of their property.
